The Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) was introduced by the Government of India in year 1950 to ensure a steady flow of skilled workers in different trades for the domestic industry, to raise quantitatively and qualitatively the industrial production by systematic training, to reduce unemployment among the educated youth by providing them employable skills, to cultivate and nurture a technical and industrial attitude in the minds of younger generation.

## **Crafts Instructor Training Scheme**

Training of Craft Instructors is the mandated responsibility of DGT and It has been operational since the inception of the Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS). Comprehensive training both in skills and training methodology is imparted to the instructor trainees to make them conversant with techniques of transferring hands-on skills, to train skilled manpower for the industry.

During admissions in academic session 2018, it was assessed that about 14,000 ITIs with seating capacity of more than 28 lakhs and the skill ecosystem have more than 95,000 instructor positions. But, only about 15% of these are currently trained under CITS. NCVT has mandated that all trainers in ITIs need to be CITS trained. Present capacity in National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) for training of trainers is 9403 per annum with total seating capacity being 12339 (including of govt. and pvt. ITOTs – 2936).

Under the Crafts Instructor Training Scheme programme, the eligible candidates are those who possess NTC/ NAC/Diploma/Degree qualifications. Training in 27 Engineering trades and 9 non-engineering trades is being offered.

### **MODE OF ADMISSION**

Admission in CITS shall be done through common entrance test(CET) conducted by DGT, New Delhi. Candidates seeking admission in CITS have to appear for common entrance test to be held generally in the month of JUNE every year as per the notifications. Trainee will be admitted in DGT field insitiute, such as ATI, chennai based upon their rank through central counselling.

Advertisement for admission to craft insrtuctor traning course shall be given in 'Employment News' paper & other leading daily newspapers generally in the month of MAY or JUNE of every year for training session commencing from AUGUST every year.

### **RESERVATION IN ADMISSION**

- 25% seats will be reserved to candidate deputed by the Directorate of State Union territories as per the prior request from the State Directorates.
- Remaining vacant seats will be filled by private candidate & candidate sponsored from private ITI based on merit only.
- Central reservation policy will be followed for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/Ex-Sm.
- 30% reservation for women candidates.

- Application with necessary enclosures should reach the institute at least 4 weeks prior to the commencement of the scheduled course.

- Preference will be given to candidates from Industries / Government Organizations / Institutions.
- Application & Registration fee once paid will not be refunded at any cost.
- Nominees should report at the Institute with the intimation letter on the day of commencement of the course at 9 AM.
- If Monday happens to be holiday, the scheduled course will commence on next working day and if Friday happens to be a holiday, the scheduled course will conclude on the previous working day.
- The Director may change / cancel any training programme without assigning any reason.
- Hostel facilities are limited & accommodation is allotted on first come first basis.
- Under any circumstances participants accompanying family members will not be provided room in the hostel. Such requests for family accommodation will not be entertained.
- The course will conclude at 5:00 PM on the last working day of the course. Certificates and Relieving orders will be issued only after 5PM on the last day.
